Infection control procedure for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Temporary visitor restrictions are in place as a measure of infection control procedure for inpatients due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

No visitors will be permitted to visit except for situations such as accompanying patients when admitted/discharged, or getting information on the patient's condition from the doctor, under the following conditions listed below.

- Visitor should be only one adult family member per patient. Visits have to be short.
- Be sure to wear a surgical mask and perform hand hygiene. We cannot provide a surgical mask. Please prepare one before you visit the hospital.
- Visitors must undergo temperature and symptom screening upon arrival.
If visitors have any symptom, including but not limited to a fever, cough or shortness of breath, they will be denied entry.
- Those who returning from overseas (all foreign countries) in the last 14 days are not allowed.
